The City of Easton Police Department offers individuals a rewarding and challenging career. There are numerous opportunities for promotion and assignment to specialized units such as Criminal Investigations, Vice Investigations, K9, Special Response Unit, Accident Investigation, Crisis Negotiations, Motorcycle Patrol and others. With 63 sworn police officers the City of Easton Police Department provides police services through preventive patrol, investigating crimes, enforcing traffic laws and responding to emergencies.

Promotional Opportunities:

Qualifications:

- Be at least 21 years of age
- Be a high school graduate or Possess a GED
- Possess a valid driver's license
- Must not have been convicted of a misdemeanor (2) or greater in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- Must not have been convicted of the equivalent of a misdemeanor (2) or greater in any other state or territory
- Must pass the physical performance test
- Must pass the written examination
- Must pass the oral examination
- Must pass a very thorough background investigation including polygraph
- Must pass medical examination including drug testing

Physical Performance Test Battery

This component of the testing process consists of 5 exercise test events. This test battery is designed to measure the cumulative effect on each applicant therefore a failure on any one test event constitutes a failure of the entire test battery and will exclude the applicant from further processing.

1. Vertical Jump – 15.5 Inches
2. Sit ups – 30 repetitions in one minute
3. 300 meter run – 66 seconds
4. Push Ups – 25 repetitions
5. 1.5 Mile Run – 15 minutes 54 seconds
